History and Geography	We will continue our History for two more weeks to complete our Ancient Egyptian study and finish with our Egyptian feast and artefacts day on Friday 26 th April, dressing as an Egyptian will be optional. Our Geography focus this term, will be learning about, why earthquakes and volcanoes happen
	and where they are found.
English	We will be reading Geography non-fiction texts and writing fact files, descriptions and glossaries. Our fiction text is called "Oliver and the Seawigs" by Philip Reeves and Sarah McIntyre. We will explore the story setting and enjoy finding out about the humorous characters through role play and through writing in role. We will write our own stories and diary entries from another character's point of view
Maths	Recognise and use fractions as numbers Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects Solve problems with money.
	Shape: Recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn Identify right angles, recognise that two right angles make a half turn, identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle. Identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines Recognise 3D shapes in different orientations and describe them.
Science	Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots stem/trunk, leaves and flowers. Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air
Plants	light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants and explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
Reading	Our class text is "Featherlight" by Peter Bunzl. We will be focusing on inference this term.
