This term, we will be holding parents' evening appointments via Teams **OR** in person at school. You need to pick **one appointment only**, either via Teams or in person at school. Please do not book both. Appointment dates and timings are outlined in the table below

We hope by offering a combination of virtual and in person appointments, we capture the requirements of as many families as possible.

From experience we know that virtual meetings enable parents the flexibility of connecting in more than one location; it eliminates travelling time; it allows working parents to attend; parents can avoid arranging alternative childcare; separated families can attend the same meeting without distress.

We politely ask families from more than one household to liaise before booking an appointment time; please only book **one** appointment per child, **not one per parent**. If there are circumstances the school is aware of where an appointment cannot be attended together, teachers will offer both parents an appointment.

The website will go live on Thursday 13th February at 10am.

Meetings will last no longer than 10 minutes – we ask parents respect the appointment time.

Teams links will be sent out closer to parents evening week.

If you are going to have difficulty accessing a device and using Teams or are unable to come in to school, we can offer a telephone meeting. Please be aware however of the difficulty of this service, as we only have one portable phone and one school telephone line.

The focus of the meeting will be to discuss:

- your child's wellbeing;
- reflections and progress;
- and the teacher's ongoing assessment of their progress to date.
