They offer: - Support for teaching PE - Festivals and competitions - CPD - Training for the sports ambassadors	Children in years 1-6 are given the opportunity to participate in sports competitions/festivals that are arranged with schools from the local area. The CPD opportunities benefit the staff and improves the teaching and learning of PE throughout the school. It provides strong links with other local schools who also participate. Sports coaches (Youth Dreams Project)	The sports coaches will: - Plan and deliver lessons throughout the year for all year groups. - Develop staff's teaching and learning of PE - Increase staff's confidence in delivering PE lessons - Deliver lunch time clubs for all year groups.	The coaches will work with classes and teachers from EYFS - Year 6. The children will benefit from being taught from a specialist coach, learning new skills and techniques. The staff will observe lessons taught by the sports coaches to develop their teaching of PE and to grow in confidence delivering the lessons. The coaches will provide lunch time clubs to increase the level of activity at lunch time and to provide a further time to learn new skills and gain in confidence.
