Topic	In topic this term, we will be looking at the Monarchy, in particular a select few Kings and Queens that helped shape the future of Great Britain.

In our writing, we will look at writing a formal letter of complaint, whilst also looking at our narrative writing and a Non-Chronological report about a chosen Monarch.
Maths	We will start our term by looking at statistics, shape and their properties and then going over the various different areas in Maths to get us ready for SATs
Science	With our science, we will be looking at Animals Including Humans, in which we will look at the circulatory systems, our hearts and what work our blood has to do in order for us to survive.
Computing	This term, we will be looking at statistics and how we can use software to enhance this and make it easier to follow.
PE	In PE this term, we will be looking at Rounders and Athletics with Mr Carr and YDP respectively.
RE	In RE we will be looking at hat can we learn from stories shared by Christians, Jews and Muslims? Creation stories compare beliefs Fruits of the spirit, Corinthians.

Equipment needed in Year 6:
