	Spring 1

Maths	We will start our term looking at ratio. This will be followed by Alegbra and decimals. We will be revisiting previous learning as well as undertaking different forms of tests in preparation for SATs.
Science	With our science, we will be looking at Inheritance and Evolution, looking at the works of Charles Darwin and how we have evolved throughout the years.
Computing	We will be looking at the understanding graphic design, looking in particular with landscapes and image editing.
PE	With the Youth Dreams Project coaches, we will be looking at Dodgeball and Gymnastics.
